#### Weavers Mennonite Church 2009-2010 Budget Offering Summary

Amount budgeted for 48 offerings \$405,308  
Offerings received through July 18 (42 offerings) \$299,489  
Total needed to meet budget by Aug. 31 \$105,819

Average budget offering through July 18 (42 offerings) \$7,131  
Average offering needed in final 6 offerings  
in order to meet budget \$17,636

Note: At our current giving rate, we will end the 2009-2010 fiscal year with a deficit of \$63,020, which will mean that our non-operating budget will only be funded at about 50% of what we budgeted.
