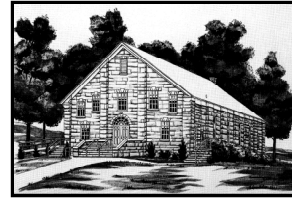


**Missionaries of the Month: Vince & LaVonne Ramella, in Istog, Kosovo.**

### Cultivating Good Soil: Assembly 2019:

- Cultivating begins with gathering music on Thursday, July 18 at 6:45 p.m. at Lindale Mennonite Church; the service celebrating VMMissions 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary begins at 7 p.m. During that service those whom VMC and VMMissions licensed or ordained within the last year, or who accepted a new assignment will also be commissioned.
