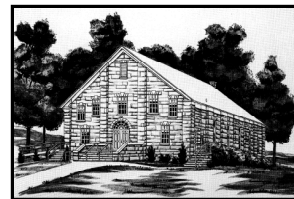


**Focus of the Month: J & M and their family, currently in the states.** Pray for them as they connect with their families here, and also as they share their stories here.
