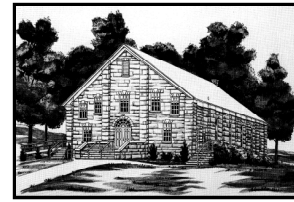

The Annual MCC Meat Canning, scheduled for February 2021 at the Hinton Mennonite Relief Center (Hinton, Va.) is **CANCELLED due to the COVID-19 pandemic**. However, in replacement of the canning project, **we plan to pack two tractor-trailer loads of MCC Bucket Relief Kits**. This project will consist of nearly 3,000 five gallon buckets full of essential personal care items. To purchase the supplies for these kits and for the ongoing operation of the Relief Center, we need \$70,000.
