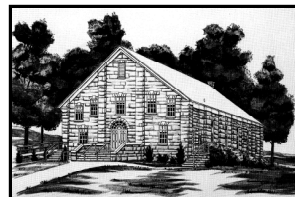

Much of our funding went to help with COVID needs this year. Outreach Committee provided \$75 gift cards that persons could request to be able to give to neighbors and friends in need. \$1000 went to VMissions for the Coronavirus Immigrant Care, and 28 gift cards were given to persons through Weavers members.

2021 SUMMER PROJECT: MDS has invited our congregation to help them build a bridge for a couple with need in Elkton. Outreach Committee is asking the congregation for funds (\$12,000) and volunteers to help build the bridge, beginning June 21 (a 10-day process). Administrative Council has approved the project. Checks can be written to Weavers and designated for MDS bridge. We will receive donations now through June, 2021. An anonymous donor will match all donations. The total cost of the bridge is about \$30,000. For more info, contact Rod Burkholder, Roy Early or Floyd Blosser who will organize the project. More info will be coming later for volunteers who can help during those 10 days in June.
