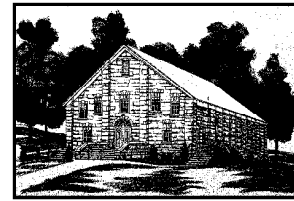




Missionaries of the Month focus:
