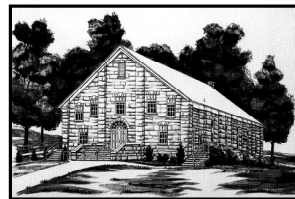


### Missionaries of the Month: Hispanic Ministries:
