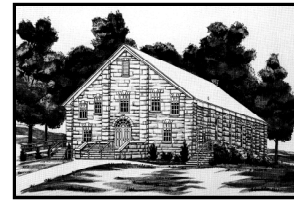

**Weekday Religious Education (WRE)** is a "release time" program for all the elementary schools in the Rockingham County Public Schools. All 2nd, 3rd, and 4th grade students are invited to attend. Children leave the school building and walk to a WRE Classroom close to the school for one period each week. Shared with the students are Bible stories, prayer and singing. It is estimated that over 60% of the students do not attend church. The WRE program is totally supported by the community that WRE serves and they are thankful for the many churches that regularly give to WRE. The upcoming Bake Sale and annual Benefit Auction uses the firstfruits of the fundraiser to purchase Bibles to give to new students. The bakesale will be held on Oct. 21, 5-7:30pm at Shady Oak of Weavers Mennonite Church; the Auction held at same location Saturday, Oct. 22 at 10AM.
