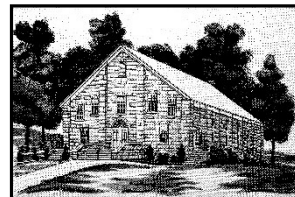

Last Sunday we heard from AVA Care of Harrisonburg as they serve our community in life-affirming medical nonprofit services to individuals at risk of or facing unintended pregnancies.
